Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions

- a. 'Exhibitor(s)' shall mean any exhibitor, trader or other pitch holder;
- b. "Lion" shall mean any member of the Organisers;
- c. "Organisers" shall mean Cambridge, Isle of Ely and Newmarket Lions Clubs;
- d. "Site" shall mean that part of the Rowley Mile Course as agreed from time to time as being the area occupied by the Show including accesses and egresses to the public highway;
- e. "Show" shall mean the Two Counties Motor Show; and
- f. "Showground" shall mean that area of the Site other than main access and egress routes.

2. Site Access The Showground will be open and available for setting up purposes from 10am to 4pm on the Saturday immediately preceding the day of the Show and on the day of the Show from 6.30am to 6.00pm. The Site must be cleared by 9.30am on the Monday immediately following the show.

3. Show Entry All Exhibitors must identify themselves to a Lion upon arrival at the entry gate before entering the Showground.

4. Vehicle Movements All Exhibitors are required to have all their exhibits in position no later than 8.30 am on the day of the Show.

Any vehicle entering or leaving the Showground between 9.30am and 5.30pm on the day of the Show must gain prior permission in writing before the show and must comply with the following:

- a. Seek assistance from a Lion for any vehicle movements and ensure you are escorted throughout the showground before any vehicle is moved;
- b. Use dipped headlights and hazard warning lights;
- c. Not exceed a speed limit of 5mph;
- d. Give way to pedestrians; and
- e. Take particular care at the entrance and exit, and keep a sharp lookout for children.

5. Site Regulations

- a. The Site must be left as found.
- b. All rubbish must be cleared by Exhibitors and placed in skips provided or removed from the Site.
- c. Precautions must be taken not to damage tarmac and grassed areas. Trailer legs must be padded and grass must not cut.
- d. Any liquid spillages are to be cleared and area made good.
- e. Vehicles placed on a sloped ground must have their wheels chocked.
- f. All Exhibitors must ensure that their exhibits, stands and associated equipment stay within their designated area as marked out by the Organisers and may have the particular offending item(s) moved if considered to be causing access and/or egress problems or affecting other Exhibitors.
- g. No animals are permitted on the site unless first agreed in writing by the Organisers.
- h. No balloons, fireworks or other flying objects are permitted on the site.

6. Liability

All exhibits, stands, goods, merchandise, or any other materials and items brought onto the showground, whether for display or sale are at the sole risk of the Exhibitors. Liability for any claims that may arise for damages or injury shall rest solely with such Exhibitor, and the Organisers expressly exclude all such liability. (See the following section marked "Insurances").

7. Insurances

The Organisers shall **not** be providing any insurance cover for this event. All Exhibitors **must provide** a current copy of their Public and Product Liability insurance certificate and for any other cover considered necessary either at time of booking or at the invoice stage.

8. Security

The Organisers shall provide two security guards for the nights of Saturday immediately preceding the show and the day of the Show up to 9.30am the next day.

9. Statutory Regulations

All Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that they comply with all current and applicable Statutory Regulations and in particular those relating to Health and Safety, Product Liability, and the Sale of Goods Act.
